**Marianopolis Science Camp is for science-minded girls and boys ages 11-15**

With its tradition of excellence in science and strong connection to McGill University and other top schools, Marianopolis College is opening its doors to a younger generation this summer. The College is pleased to introduce Marianopolis Science Camp, a hands-on day camp for girls and boys ages 11 to 15.

Inside Marianopolis College's new computer and science labs, campers will engage in challenging and age-appropriate experiments in robotics, physics, chemistry and more. On the College's green spaces and in its state-of-the-art double gymnasium, they will have more traditional summertime fun, from soccer to basketball. While enjoying a superior instructor to camper ratio, campers will hear from guest scientists, go on day trips to the city's world-renowned science centres and choose among such offerings as:

- Intelligent Machines: exploring the world of Lego robotics and creating mechanical and smart models
- The Physical Universe: discovering scientific concepts in physics in an interactive, engaging way
- What's the Matter?: building a sustainable future via solar power and renewable energy.

The camp will run July 6 to July 24. Budding scientists may sign up for a week or all three. Each week costs \$245. There are reduced rates for early registration (ending March 31), siblings and those attending more than one week. The camp offers extended hours care.

Marianopolis Science Camp is located at 4873 Westmount Ave. in Westmount, a short walk from Villa Maria metro station and on bus routes 124, 138 and 24.
