



FIRST AID KITS

First Aid Kits are available on each level of the College so that basic treatment of minor cuts, scrapes and abrasions can be provided immediately while waiting for help to arrive. Locations are as follows:

- **100 LEVEL** - Wayne's World A-101, Student Services A-106*, Nurse's Office A-166*, Health Center A-168, Gym supervision room-J-005
- **200 LEVEL** - Reception A-203B, Secretariat A-214, Admissions A-211, Business Office A 269, Library C-202, Music Classroom F-217, Biology lab G-206
- **300 LEVEL** - T.L.T A-358, Chemistry lab G-306*
- **400 LEVEL** - Art studio A-404, Computer lab I-411

In general, kits include:

antiseptic towelettes (to clean out a wound)
band-aids
sterile gauze pads
triangular bandage (for slings)
pressure bandage (to help stop bleeding)
emergency blanket (to cover someone in case of shock)
elastic bandage (for sprains)
gauze dressing
adhesive tape
scissors & tweezers
rubber gloves (to be worn in all instances when dealing with blood)
