## SMOKE-FREE POLICY

### 1. DATE

Adopted by the Board of Governors on March 26, 2019.

### 2. PURPOSE

Marianopolis College is committed to safeguarding the health and well-being of all members of its community by fostering an environment free of the harmful effects of smoking, vaping and consuming cannabis.

This policy establishes Marianopolis as a smoke-free and cannabis-free college pursuant to the Tobacco Control Act, the Politique de lutte contre le tabagisme dans les établissements d'enseignement collégial et universitaire and the Cannabis Regulation Act.

### 3. SCOPE

This policy applies to all persons while on the College's campus and during all College-sanctioned activities, whether academic, recreational, athletic or otherwise, occurring on campus or off. This includes but is not limited to courses, academic activities, sports, clubs, associations, trips and events.

### 4. DEFINITIONS

**Campus:** any indoor or outdoor area of the College's premises, including, without limitation, all buildings, grounds, structures and vehicles.

**College:** Marianopolis College as a legal entity.

**Smoking products:** any product or class of product containing tobacco, cannabis, vaping liquid or substance or aerosol produced by vaping. This includes, without limitation, electronic cigarettes, any other devices of that nature that are used to inhale any substance that may or may not contain nicotine, their components and accessories.

### 5. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

5.1. The Board of Governors approves this policy and any revisions thereto.

5.2. The Director General is responsible for:

- ensuring that this policy is applied;

- reporting on the application of this policy to the Board of Governors every two years and submitting the report to the Minister of Health and Social Services within sixty days of filing it with the Board of Governors;
- reviewing this policy periodically.

## **6. POLICY**

- 6.1. The use of smoking products is prohibited, except in the designated outdoor area in effect until further notice.
- 6.2. The use and possession of cannabis in any form is prohibited.
- 6.3. Violations of this policy will be subject to sanctions, which will be governed by the Code of Student Conduct, relevant working conditions or applicable legislation.
- 6.4. The College will provide education and support measures to students and employees who are smokers and who wish to quit smoking.
