

GENERAL INFORMATION

- **COURSE DATES:** All summer courses are taught in person and **begin on June 2**. Courses take place weekdays except June 24 and July 1. The final exam date is included in the dates listed.
- **MAXIMUM COURSES:** You may take a maximum of **two** summer courses.
- **UNPAID TUITION:** You may not register if you have an outstanding tuition balance.
- **COURSES AT ANOTHER COLLEGE:** You may be given authorization to register for a course at another college **only if** Marianopolis does not offer a course that you need this summer to graduate or to proceed with your courses in the fall. Please MIO an Academic Advisor if you are in this situation.
- **COURSE CANCELLATIONS:** Courses are subject to change or cancellation without prior notice.

REGISTRATION FOR MARIANOPOLIS STUDENTS

If you are graduating this summer:

- Registration: 12:30-14:30, room A-269
Students in Social Science, Music, ALC, Liberal Arts, Arts and Sciences, Double DEC: April 21
Students in Pure and Applied and Health Science: April 23
- Payment deadline: April 30 through online banking

If you are returning in the fall and you are behind by one or more courses in your progression (e.g. due to failure, dropped courses, incomplete courses, reduced course load):

- Registration: 12:30-14:30, room A-269
Students in Pure and Applied and Health Science: April 28
Students in Social Science, Music, ALC, Liberal Arts, Arts and Sciences, Double DEC: April 30
- Payment deadline: May 7 through online banking

If you fail a course in the Winter 2026 semester:

- When you receive your final grade, you may register with an Academic Advisor during regular drop-in hours. The last day to register is June 1, 14:00, room A-269.
- Payment deadline: Payment must be made the day you register, through online banking

If you are not behind by any courses but you want to get ahead in your progression, registration is permitted where space allows:

- Registration: June 1, 16:00-17:00, room A-269
- Payment deadline: Payment must be made the day you register, through online banking

REGISTRATION FOR STUDENTS FROM OTHER COLLEGES

If you are graduating this summer:

- An Academic Advisor at your college must send a *commandite* form by May 22, 16:00.
- You will receive an email on June 1 by 16:00 to inform you whether you have been registered in the course. The payment deadline is June 2, through online banking.

FEEES AND PAYMENT INSTRUCTIONS

If you do not pay by the deadline stated above, your course(s) will be dropped. Pay through **online banking**: add "Marianopolis College" as a payee and use your permanent code as your account number.
